# KRGC MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION ADDENDUM SAFETY TRAINING for 2025

You must read and initial each section, certifying you have read and understood the training information provided. Include this addendum with your application.

Section 1 – By Laws pertaining to membership and conduct.	Initials

**Article III, Section A – Membership:** Members who have paid their dues are entitled to voting privileges and access to the range and participation in all club sponsored events. Club dues are due on January 1<sup>st</sup>. If not received by January 31<sup>st</sup> membership will be terminated. Any returned checks may result in termination of access until resolved. **All members will be required to pass a Range Safety Training.** 

**Article IX, Section 1 – Suspension of Membership:** A member failing to pay annual club dues, repeatedly acts in an unsafe manner on the range, or whose actions reflect badly on the Konocti Rod and Gun Club, may be suspended or terminated from all membership privileges and shall not be permitted to use the range in connection with the Konocti Rod and Gun Club.

Section 2 – RFID Cards, Security Cameras, and Guest Waivers	Initials
---	----------

DO NOT share your gate RFID membership card. Your card is specific to you and electronically records your name, date and time of your entry and exit to the range.

- DO NOT write on the cards.
- There is a \$50 replacement fee for the RFID membership card.
- Report lost or stolen card right away so it can be deactivated.
- If you have no plans to renew your membership, mail your card back to the club.
- If you are late in renewing your membership, hold onto your card and it can be reactivated.

Security cameras are located on the range and record activity.

All guests must sign the range Waiver Form. Place signed waivers in the mailbox located on the front of the pistol range building. A guest is a non-member coming onto the range, as a shooter or spectator with a member. Parents or guardians sign waivers for guests under 18.

<mark>Initials</mark>		

- Everyone on the range is expected to be courteous and respectful of others.
- All targets must be elevated, approximately 5 ft high, to impact the 100-yard berm.

- No cross firing, shoot straight down range from under the firing line cover.
- Handguns are permitted on the rifle range.
- Loaded firearms allowed on the firing line and pointed down range ONLY.
- No one is allowed down range of the firing line when firearms are loaded.
- Anyone may call a "Cease Fire".
- Open actions required outside of the firing line.
- Eye and hearing protection required for all shooters and guests.
- Any shooter under 18 must be supervised by a qualified adult.
- Shooting prohibited while intoxicated by drugs or alcohol.
- Do NOT shoot at non target items that may be on the range.
- Clay pigeons are NOT allowed on the range.
- Clean up your brass and pick up your hulls.
- Take all trash home including your targets, cardboard, and damaged sticks.

#### Section 4 – Using the Pistol Range

**Initials** 

- Handgun use only.
- If pistol range is in use, handguns can be used at the rifle range.
- DO NOT shoot under the awning of the pistol range building.
- Place your targets near the berm to ensure your rounds impact the berm and NOT the ground.
- Clean up your brass.
- Leave no trash behind.
- Return the moveable target stands to the rifle range.

# **Section 5 – Targets**

Initials

KRGC provides some target stands and sticks that are to be placed in the moveable stands or in the mounted holders located behind the railroad ties at the 5-, 15-, 50-, 100- and 200- yard lines.

- Bring cardboard at least 24 inches wide to attach to the sticks in the stand holders.
- Bring targets to be affixed to the cardboard.
- Bring a stapler and staples to affix the cardboard and targets.

Members are allowed to bring personal target stands. Targets must be mounted high enough, so rounds impact the 100-yard berm.
